Army Group Don was activated in November 1942 and was commanded by Field Marshal Erich von Manstein. Its sector was in central and southern Russia. In addition to its German elements, the Rumanian 3d Army was also under the command of Army Group Don. On February 14, 1943, the Army Group was redesignated Army Group South.
