Heeresgruppe Weichsel (Army Group Vistula)

Army Group Vistula was activated on January 24, 1945 with headquarters in Schneidemuehl, under the command of Reichsführer-SS Heinrich Himmler. Its mission was to close the gap between Army Groups Mitte (Center) and A, to prevent a Russian breakthrough in the direction of Danzig and Posen and the encirclement of East Prussia, and to organize the defensive forces on German soil behind the entire Eastern Front. Himmler was replaced by General Gotthard Heinrici on March 21, 1945. Subsequent commanding generals were Lieutenant General Kurt von Tippelskirch and General Kurt Student. The Army Group was disbanded on May 8, 1945.
