

III. Panzerkorps (III Panzer Corps)

The III Panzer Corps was formed in 1934 as an infantry corps and corps-area headquarters by expansion of the 3rd Division of the old Reichswehr. It fought in Poland in 1939 and in the West in 1940 as the III Infantry Corps. The Corps shared in the invasion of Russia as the III Panzer Corps and fought on the southern sector of the Eastern front. It played an important role in the operations involving the capture of Kharkov and Rostov. In late 1944 the Corps took part in the defense of Hungary.
