

IV. Armeekorps (IV Corps)

The IV Corps was formed in 1934 as an infantry corps and corps-area headquarters by the expansion of the 4th Division of the old Reichswehr. It fought in Poland in 1939 and in the West in 1940. The Corps took part in the Russian campaign and fought on the southern sector of that front. For a short period (July 1941-Feb. 1942) the Corps was redesignated as Gruppe von Schwedler. The Corps was virtually destroyed at Stalingrad in January 1943. It was reformed in the summer of 1943 as the IV Infantry Corps. Later the Corps served on the southern sector of the Eastern front. During the withdrawal from the lower Dnjestr in August 1944 the Corps suffered severe casualties. Early in 1945 it was converted to the IV Panzer Corps. The Commander was General Ulrich Kleemann.
