This is not an oral interview. A list of questions on the German method of writing the history of the war was written out by me in English, translated into German by M/Sgt. Kiralfy, and then presented to General Warlimont, and he had several days in which to prepare the answers in German to these questions. The German manuscript is missing. A translation of General Warlimont's remarks was prepared by M/Sgt. Kiralfy, and that is what constitutes ETHINT 7.

A shorter set of questions was submitted at the same time to Major Herbert Buechs, but because the German manuscript was preserved, the answers to these questions are in a different series and may be found as MS # A-867.
